PRIMARY DRESS CODE

Students are asked to be mindful that they are in a school environment and are to dress accordingly. We ask students to use common sense and discretion when dressing for school and expect students to adhere to the following dress code rules:

CLOTHES

- **Should be labelled!**
- Are to be clean, neat, and in good repair.
- Are to be practical, suitable for a school setting, and not impede or restrict movement.
- Examples of unsuitable items include:
 - beachwear,
 - party wear,
 - sleeveless tops,
 - off the shoulder tops,
 - low cut shorts/trousers,
 - excessively baggy or tight jeans/trousers,
 - mini-shorts.
- A mix of colours with minimum use of black, logos and designer labels. Consideration also should be taken in choosing clothing with appropriate printed images.
- A full change of clothes, gumboots and raincoats are expected to be available at all times for wet weather and accidents.
- As the school is a Sun Smart school, wide brimmed hats are compulsory for Terms 1 & 4.

Tarremah hats can be purchased at the office.

SPORT

- Students will be required to wear clothing that's appropriate for physical activity on sport days.
- For example:
 - track pants
 - shorts
 - sports shoes with adequate support
- Long hair **must** be tied up for sport.

SHOES

- Must be worn at all times on school property
- Sensible and practical shoes should be worn that allow for a variety of activities. Such as sports shoes, walking shoes, closed toe sandals, etc.
- No platforms, backless shoes/sandals, fashion shoes, thongs, shoes/sandals that barely cover feet and toes, etc.

SWIM WEAR (for swimming lessons and camps)

- Girls - one piece (with board-shorts, if preferred, not excessively large or long legged, for lessons).
- Boys - speedos or board-shorts (not excessively large or long legged, for lessons).
- Swimming caps are required for swimming lessons.

JEWELLERY AND ACCESSORIES

- Studs and sleeper in ears only
- Watches allowed from class three onwards.
- Please no bracelets, anklets, rings or necklaces.

HAIR

- Hair must be neat, and clean.
- Common sense and discretion should apply to hair styles.
- Long hair (hair that reaches the shoulder) is to be tied back at all times and long fringes to be secured away from the face.

MAKE-UP

- No make up allowed or dyed hair or tattoos.
