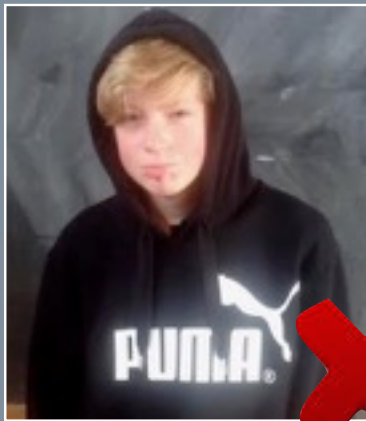


# DRESS



Wide Brimmed Hats **MUST** be worn in Terms 1 & 4.



Minimum use of black.  
Minimum use of logos.



No exposed shoulders.



Sensible Shoes to be worn at all times.

# REVISED DRESS CODE

Full brimmed hats are compulsory for Terms 1 and 4

Students are asked to be mindful that they are in a school environment and are to dress accordingly. We ask students to use common sense and discretion when dressing for school and expect students to adhere to the following dress code rules:

## CLOTHES

- **Should be labelled!**
- Are to be clean, neat, and in good repair.
- Are to be practical, suitable for a school setting, and not impede or restrict movement.
- A mix of colours with minimum use of black
- A minimum of logos and designer labels.
- Examples of unsuitable items include:
  - beachwear,
  - party wear,
  - midriff/low-cut tops,
  - sleeveless tops,
  - off the shoulder tops,
  - low cut shorts/trousers,
  - mini-skirts,
  - excessively baggy jeans/trousers,
  - excessively tight jeans/trousers/shorts,
  - mini-shorts.
- As the school is a Sun Smart school, wide brimmed hats are compulsory for Terms 1 & 4.

All students are expected to dress in "Neat Casual" attire when leaving campus for an excursion, unless otherwise specified.

## SPORT

- Students will be required to wear clothing that's appropriate for physical activity on Sport Days.
- For example:
  - trackpants
  - shorts
  - sports shoes with adequate support
- Long hair **must** be tied up for Sport.
- All jewellery except studs/sleepers must be taken off for sports/ gymnastics classes.

## SHOES

- Sports shoes, walking shoes, etc.
- No platforms, high heels, backless shoes/sandals, fashion shoes, thongs, crocs etc.
- Some subjects, e.g., Chemistry and Woodwork require enclosed shoes to be worn.

## SWIM WEAR (for swimming lessons and camps)

- Girls - one piece (with board-shorts, if preferred, not excessively large or long legged, for lessons).
- Boys - speedos or board-shorts (not excessively large or long legged, for lessons).

## JEWELLERY

- Discreet, and minimal, jewellery which is practical in a classroom environment permitted.
- All jewellery except studs/sleepers must be taken off for sports/ gymnastics classes.

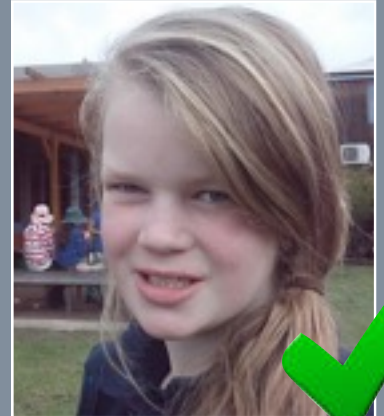
## HAIR

- Hair must be neat, and clean.
- Common sense and discretion should apply to hair styles.
- Long hair secured away from face. (Including long fringes.)
- Students with long hair should bring a hair tie every day, in case an activity requires hair to be tied back for safety reasons. e.g. sport.

## MAKE-UP

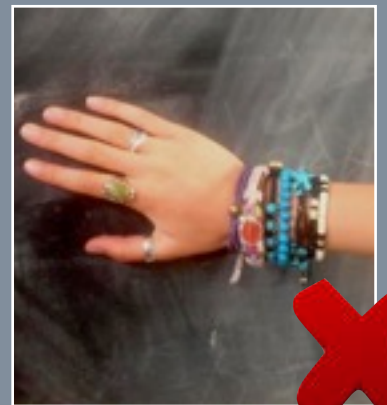
- Makeup, if worn, must be light, and unobtrusive.

## HAIR,



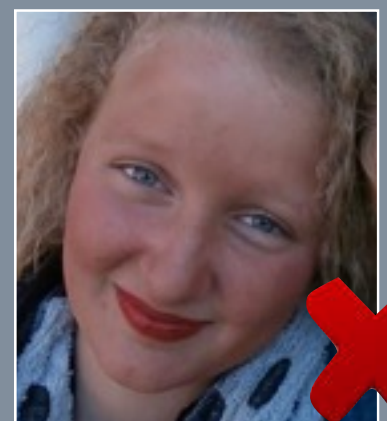
*Hair tied back, ready for sport.*
